

ow wonderful it is to look out of the window and see the change of season, it brings us such joy and hope and, for us gardeners, a lot of preparation work and as often said much blood, sweat and tears before we see our gardens full of colour, beautiful blooms and wonderful scents. I will ask you to pause here for a moment since the message I have, will chill your souls and spread a winter chill in your hearts.


In March 2024 the Canadian Institute for Health Research published the 2022 Canadian, induced abortion statistics, which were up 11% (9,726 more little ones) on the 2021 figures to 97,211 for 2022/2023 with **40,313** of these procured in Ontario! On a Freedom of Information request, which was carried out by a colleague, it seems we are getting better at ensuring that late-term abortion births are decreasing by 18 from 149 in 2021/2022 to 131 in 2022/2023. Being very blunt, we are better at killing these little ones before they are born it seems. However, stillbirths after abortion on children 20 weeks gestation or older have increased from **911** in 2021/2022 to **1.059** in 2022/2023 - that is 148 more dead children, Further requests produced the following in a table header which reads Table 1: Number of stillbirths resulting in termination of pregnancy in acute inpatient settings in Canada (excluding Quebec, by province, **2021/2022** - within this table of **911** children 149 were aged 20 weeks or older at the time they were killed and 442 of the total were procured in Ontario. The same table for the 2022/2023 year showed a total of 1,059 dead children with 502 of the occurring in Ontario and 131 children were 20 weeks gestation or older! I also made a request for information regarding Mifegymiso, the chemical abortion procedure, and compared to the 2020/2021 year, these abortions appear to have doubled in Ontario reaching 28,524 prescription claims in our province for the 2022/2023 year.

The reason I am providing this information is to highlight the growing callousness that is becoming apparent in the medical field regarding the killing of children before birth. It does not matter what age, size a child is when it is killed by medical professionals via abortion – but the disregard that is now very evident for us all to see is more obvious when the child is older. I cannot imagine the callousness that is required to kill almost 17 children at 20 weeks gestation, 100 children who were 21-24 weeks gestation, 9 at 25-28 weeks or the 7 who were 29 weeks. The hardened medical hearts are also apparent in

the horrendous numbers we are now seeing overall of 97,211 induced abortions in Canada. Our voice is needed now more than ever. Information of how you can be a part can be found further inside this newsletter.

Our board is also preparing a strategy to alert the community to the dangers of allowing physicians to kill patients at the end of life. It appears to us that the medical profession in certain areas has discarded its ethics regarding doing no harm to patients. What is so distressing, is that there are hundreds of ethical health professionals who are caught up in this terrible move by many of their colleges and colleagues, to change the medical profession from one of care to one of killing. We need to keep them in our hearts as they face discrimination and censure for their world view. We did have a wonderful situation on Easter Sunday when I was contacted by a physician who was helping a young woman who had taken the first abortion pill, to get assistance to reverse it. After three hours and from two continents we were able to connect this young woman with a physician close to her who would try and assist her to save her child. This is what medicine used to be and must become again – please keep this young woman and these wonderful physicians in your hearts.

Lastly, we made our presentation to the City Advertising Review Panel on April 12th, 2024, and we are awaiting the decision within 21 days. Our ads are truthful and factual, and we believe there is no reason that would stand up anywhere in our democracy which should



prevent us from purchasing advertising space on Guelph City buses to display them. Of course, there is the possibility of discrimination and censorship, but surely not?????


